On behalf of the Health team at the World Economic Forum, we welcome this opportunity to come together at this critical time with leaders from the public and private sector to focus on shaping the future of health transformation.

Indeed health challenges are continuing to rise at alarming levels (NCDs, obesity, diabetes, cardiometabolic disease, mental health). In parallel, there are significant and growing potential existential threats to human health (climate change, biothreats, antimicrobial resistance).
